



Dear St. Francis Xavier Parents,

The B.A.S.E (Before And After School Recreational Experience) is a program offered for working parents who need care before and after school. The program is offered at St. Francis Xavier School in Joyce Hall for 1st through 8th grade students and at East Campus for Kindergarten students. A registration form and a waiver must be completed and submitted to the Park District of La Grange. The registration fee is \$30.00 per child. You may obtain the registration form and waiver on the BASE website (www.pdlg-base.org) or at the Park District of La Grange. Registration forms and fees will not be accepted at the school. Registration will only be accepted at the Park District of La Grange.

What is B.A.S.E?

B.A.S.E is a program designed to meet the needs of working parents and their children. The major goal of the Before and After School Recreational Experience is to create a nurturing, secure and safe environment for the children. The key to a successful program is to provide a flexible, enriched atmosphere with appropriate recreational activities to meet the developmental needs of the children as well as complement the school curriculum. The B.A.S.E program strives to meet each child and family's need, encourages each child to make good positive choices, achieve independence and responsibility and develop on going friendships.

How Do I Sign Up For B.A.S.E?

Parents interested in the BASE recreational program will need to fill out a registration form, sign the waiver and return the forms to the Park District of La Grange. After we receive the forms with payment, your child will be put on the B.A.S.E registration list or on the wait list if the program has exceeded capacity. Checks must be made out to the Park District of La Grange.

Wednesdays- 6:45 a.m to 8:15 a.m and 2:00 p.m to 6:00 p.m
